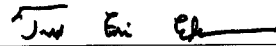
ORDER

The above-captioned cases have been consolidated for the purposes of management of pretrial discovery. On July 20, 2026, the undersigned's chambers inquired via electronic mail whether the parties would be available for a Status Hearing on August 4, 2026 to discuss any discovery issues that have arisen or that may be anticipated. The parties provided their availability via electronic mail. Accordingly, it is therefore this 21st day of July, 2026, hereby

ORDERED that a Status Hearing in this matter is SCHEDULED on August 4, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. in Courtroom 233 of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia, 500 Indiana Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. While in-person appearances are preferred, the Defendants and their attorneys may appear remotely over WebEx as necessary. It is advised that failure of any Defendant to appear may result in the issuance of a bench warrant for his or her arrest; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent they have not already done so, government counsel shall contact counsel for Defendants Carrero, Thiers, and Dennison-Gibby by close of business on July 22, 2026 to determine if they or their agents wish to observe, document, and/or test the present physical condition of the Reflecting Pool and,

if so, to make appropriate arrangements for them to do so.
