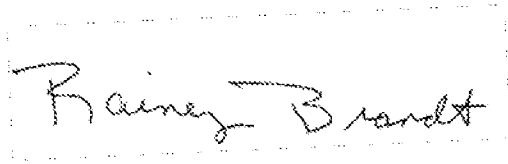
CONSOLIDATION ORDER

On July 20, 2026, the Government submitted a letter requesting that certain cases relating to “damage to the Reflecting Pool on June 19th and 20th, 2026” be consolidated for the purpose of handling pretrial discovery issues. The Court finds that it is prudent and in the interests of justice to grant the Government’s request and consolidate case numbers 2026 CMD 010450, 2026 CMD 010451, and 2026 CMD 010494 with *United States v. David Hearn*, 2026 CF2 010237 for the purpose of pretrial discovery litigation on Felony 1 Calendar 1 before the Honorable Todd Edelman.¹

Accordingly, this Order hereby consolidates 2026 CMD 010450, 2026 CMD 010451, 2026 CMD 010494 and, 2026 CF2 010237 for the purposes of pretrial discovery litigation before Judge Edelman. A next hearing date will be set by Judge Edelman’s chambers. Any subsequent trials set on the *Carreno, Thiers and Dennison-Gibby* matters will be handled before the assigned calendar judge.

¹ The Court expects that two additional cases against Nicholas Allan Coffelt and Alexa Anne Roux will be papered in the near future. When those cases related to the Reflecting Pool are papered, they will also be consolidated under this Order.
